ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Oxford Brookes University Advanced Professional Program in Coaching Supervision is designed for experienced coaches with an active coaching practice who already have a postgraduate qualification in Coaching, Psychology or equivalent.

The program provides experienced coaches with an opportunity to extend their competences and skills into the area of coaching supervision. The full program comprises four stages, three of which are optional.

Oxford Brookes has been a leading provider of postgraduate education for coaching supervisors since 2006. This program was offered for the first time in the USA in 2019.

The Advanced Professional Program in Coaching Supervision at Oxford Brookes University provides a pathway to accreditation with the EMCC as a coach supervisor.



Dr Peter Jackson is Deputy Director of the International Centre for Coaching and Mentoring Studies at Oxford Brookes University. He has contributed to a number of book chapters and academic papers on topics including reflective learning, coach education, supervision and embodiment. He is co-editor with Tatiana Bachkirova and David Clutterbuck of 'Coaching Supervision: Theory & Practice' and currently has another collection on coaching research in production with SAGE publications.



Professor Tatiana Bachkirova is Professor of Coaching Psychology and Director of the International Centre for Coaching and Mentoring Studies at Oxford Brookes University. Tatiana is a recognized author, international speaker and holder of an achievement award in recognition of distinguished contribution to coaching psychology from the British Psychological Society.



Angela Wright has over 25 years global professional experience including 12 years as a coach, coach supervisor, educator, and researcher. In 2018, she received the EMCC Coaching Supervision award. Angela has written a number of chapters and academic papers, including contributing to the most recent edition of Coaching Supervision: Theory & Practice.



Sarah Tennyson is an organizational psychologist, a certified Coach Supervisor and Alumni of this program, Sarah provides individual and group supervision for internal and external coaches and has published research on the topic. Sarah is a certified team coach and holds an MSc. Organizational Psychology and BSc. (Hons) Psychology.

STAGE 1a Preparation

This consists of two months of preparation during which participants undertake preliminary reading, reflection, peer-supervision, and supervision practice.

Participants will be paired for peer-supervision (at least two sessions) according to guidance provided that will include tasks for reflection and preparation. In addition, they will be asked to deliver at least one supervision session for a volunteer coach.

This stage is to be completed between March 1st and April 30th, 2021. There is an expectation that participants will commence this preparation as soon as possible after March 1st, 2021. This is a compulsory part of the program and must be completed prior to the online workshops.

The minimum reading will include specifically designed materials and selected chapters from the book: Bachkirova, T., Jackson, P. & Clutterbuck, D. (Eds), (2011) Coaching and Mentoring Supervision: Theory and Practice, Maidenhead: Open. A copy of this book will be provided and is included in the fee.

STAGE 1b Online Workshops

The interactive, practical online workshops include discussion, co-active reflection, experiential activities, and group supervision.

The next online workshops are planned for May 10th – 12th | May 17th – 19th | May 24th – 26th, 2021.

Participants are not initiated into a particular approach to supervision but are encouraged to experiment with the variety of approaches in order to identify their own model and style of supervision by:

- Exploring conceptual issues, coaching discourses and theoretical perspectives on supervision
- Engaging with a deeper understanding of the supervision process and related issues
- Experimenting with a variety of skills essential for coaching supervisors

Upon completion of stage 1a and 1b participants will receive a **Certificate of Attendance**. Program graduates are invited to Oxford Brookes annual coaching supervision conferences and colloquiums.

Fees for Stages 1a & 1b are \$4500.00 including the online workshops scheduled May 10th – 12th | May 17th – 19th & May 24th – 26th, 2021

STAGE 2

Participants may choose to take two (1.5 hours) or three (1 hour) individual supervision sessions on their supervision with one of the program tutors. This will start after the intensive course.

The sessions will allow the participants to receive individualized developmental feedback on their Model of coaching supervision in practice. Prior to each supervision session with the program tutors, you will need to have undertaken at least three practice supervision sessions of your own.

For candidates who wish to receive the Professional Certificate of Advanced Study in Coaching Supervision this stage is a requirement prior to undertaking the stage 3 assessment referred to below.

Stage 2 is to be completed within 2 years of completion of stage 1b.

STAGE 3

The stage 3 assessment consists of one written assignment: Description and Analysis of the candidate's Model of coaching supervision. The Model of coaching supervision comprises the 3 P's:

- Your Philosophy
- Your Purpose
- Your Process

Stage 3 is to be completed within 2 years of completion of stage 1b.

Upon successful completion of Stages 2 and 3 participants will receive the **Professional Certificate of Advanced Study in Coaching Supervision**.

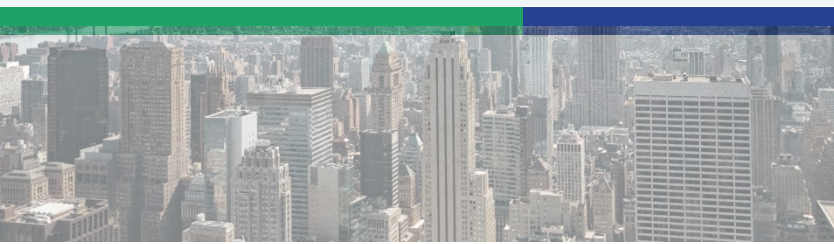
STAGE 4

This stage is conditional upon successful completion of the assessment at Stage 3 of the program and will consist of:

- An additional assessment that includes a written portfolio with the candidate's analysis of two video/audio tapes: one of their "best" and one of their 'worst' supervision sessions; and
- An interview with Oxford Brookes University Faculty.

Stage 4 is to be completed within 3 years of completion of stage 1b.

Upon completion of stage 4, participants will be **Accredited as a Coaching Supervisor** by Oxford Brookes University.
